GARNACHA

This is a wine made with grapes from Gualtallary – Tupungato, in the heart of the Uco Valley. The grapes were extracted from vines which are located on sandy soils where we can find many pebble stones. Syrah comes from of Pareditas, located in the department of San Carlos, in the Uco Valley.

This wine is composed of 85% Grenache and 15% Syrah.

To make it we use a pool of cement with epoxy in the which a co-fermentation takes place between both arietals. By having two varietals with different ripening cycles, we use the tannic contribution from the Syrah stem that is ripe to grant a different structure in the mouth and playing with the notes herbaceous from maceration during the fermentation process. Once finished, the wine rests in the same basin for 6 months to be bottled. It does not have passage through a barrel.
